


County Court Judgments (CCJs)

A County Court Judgement is an order that is made by the Court upon an individual or companies' failure to repay money that is rightfully owed.

Prior to receiving a CCJ, a debtor should be served with an initial Letter of Claim which will give a breakdown of any sums due and a deadline to settle the debt. Upon failure to comply with this letter, a further warning letter may be issued, or the creditors could alternatively commence with legal proceedings without further notice.

If a claim is issued, a copy of the same will be sent to the debtor/company who is afforded the opportunity to defend the claim. A debtor will then have 14 days to respond. Failure to respond will lead to a default judgment being made without any consideration of the debtor's circumstances.

Upon receipt of a claim a debtor/company should immediately address the claim and/or seek legal advice as a failure to do so is likely to result in a CCJ being made against them.

At Lawson-West, we advise all of our clients to attempt to settle disputes outside of the Court prior to incurring the additional and unnecessary costs associated with bringing a claim to the court.

!!! Having a CCJ can have an adverse effect on a company's ability to obtain credit and can result in difficulties for the company when trading.
